DAYS/TIMES: Monday/Wednesday OR Tuesday/Thursday, 6:30PM-7:30 PM

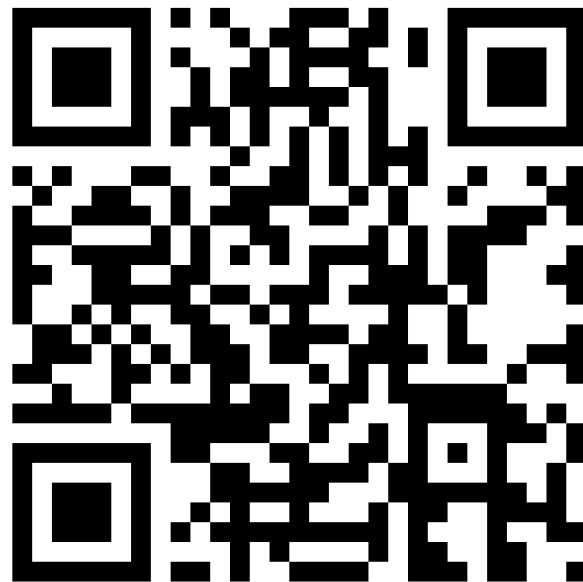
